

# Human FGF21 Protein

## Description

<b>Source</b>	Recombinant Human FGF21 Protein is expressed from HEK293 with His tag at the N-Terminus. It contains His29-Ser209.
<b>Accession</b>	Q9NSA1-1
<b>Molecular Weight</b>	The protein has a predicted MW of 20.2 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 25-30 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
<b>Endotoxin</b>	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
<b>Purity</b>	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE > 95% as determined by HPLC

## Formulation and Storage

<b>Formulation</b>	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
<b>Storage</b>	-20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt. -80°C for 3-6 months after reconstitution. 2-8°C for 2-7 days after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

## Background

Fibroblast growth factor 21 (FGF21) is a peptide hormone that is synthesized by several organs and regulates energy homeostasis. Excitement surrounding this relatively recently identified hormone is based on the documented metabolic beneficial effects of FGF21, which include weight loss and improved glycemia.

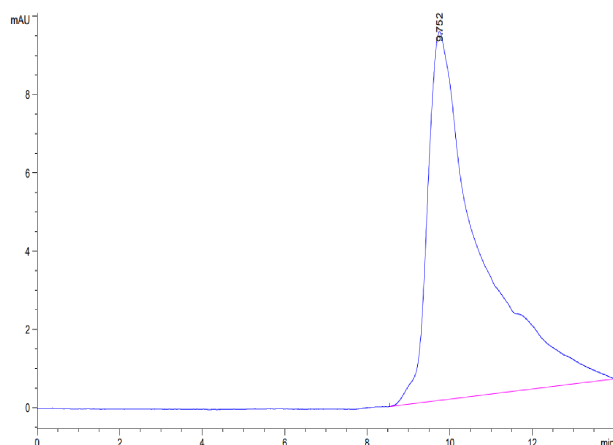
## Assay Data

Human FGF21 on Tris-Bis PAGE under reduced condition. The purity is greater than 95%.

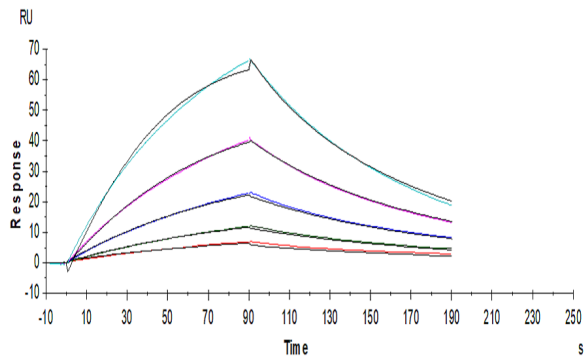
### SEC-HPLC
